How to book and pay.

- Check through the booklet, decide what you want to do.
- When bookings open – book online or by returning the booking form.
- You will receive a confirmation of your booking by email with details of how to pay. If trips are full you will be placed on a reserve list.
Please wait for this confirmation before paying.
- Make payment by the deadline – if you do not pay by this date you *will* lose your spaces.
- After payment deadline we send out confirmations with pickup times and will allocate any spaces to people on the reserve list.
- If you have been allocated spaces from the reserve list you must pay by the reserve payment deadline.
- Meet us on the day at the bus pickup point and we will check you onto the bus.

Important Dates!

- **Bookings open – Friday 12th June** – You can book online or return your form from this date.
- **Payment deadline – Friday 17th July** – Please pay this date or you will lose your booking.
- **Reserve list open – Monday 20th July** – if you have been placed on a reserve list and we have spaces open we will contact you around this date
- **Reserve payments – Monday 27th July** – payment for spaces from the reserve list need to be paid by this date.

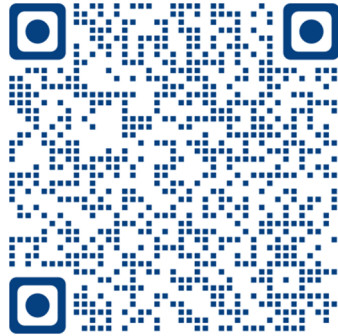

Parents / Carers are responsible for children and others in their care at all times.

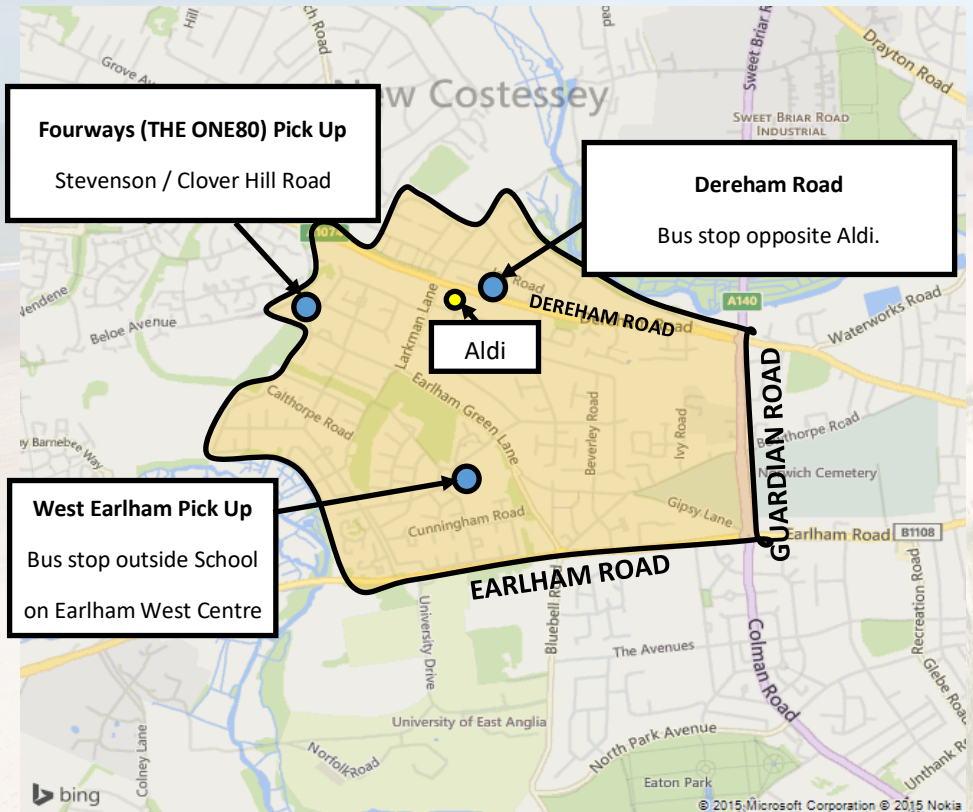
Refunds - Refunds are only available if trips are cancelled with 72 hours notice. Refunds may take 2-3 weeks to process.

Catchment Area and Pick Up Points

SORTED is part of Henderson Trust which is a registered charity. We can only offer the trips to those living in our area of benefit. The area is highlighted on the map below, but is generally speaking the **NRS 8 postcode**. All trips will have the same pickup and drop off points as shown below.



Travel

Please note that children under the age of three **may** require either a car or booster seat appropriate to their requirements, this is at your own discretion and they are not provided by the coach company. **NO** children to travel on laps. The parent/guardian is responsible for the child being seated correctly and for the fitting of any car or booster seats. Seatbelts must be worn when traveling on the coach.

NO unaccompanied children (18 years and under) will be taken.

What's On?

Tuesday 28th July - Pettitts

Approximate Time - 10am - 4pm - Adult/Child - £15, U3 - £3.50

Pettitts is a lovely relaxed day out for families, particularly those with younger children. The main rides are all included in the price. With live shows, animals and rides, Pettitts is known as one of Norfolk's premier parks.



Wednesday 29th July - Hemsby Beach

Approximate Time - 10am - 4pm - All Ages - £3.50

Our traditional beach trip to Hemsby. Please be aware that although the beach is accessible (at the minute!) the tide can come in quite high, luckily there's lots of other things to do!



Wednesday 5th August - Sea Palling Beach

Approximate Time - 10am - 4pm - All Ages - £3.50

We love Sea Palling with its rock pools and sandy beach to explore. Close to the beach are the amusement arcade, playing field, fish and chip shop...and probably the best whippy ice-creams in Norfolk!



Friday 7th August - Bewilderwood

Approximate Time - 10am - 4pm - Adult/Child - £19, U3 - £3.50

BeWILDerwood is an award-winning, enchanted woodland adventure park focused on imaginative, natural play. It features treehouses, zip lines, mazes, and boat rides, offering a magical, screen-free day out for families.



Tuesday 11th August - Thetford BBQ

Approximate Time - 10am - 4pm - Adult/Child - £8, U3 - £3.50

Our now annual event...The BBQ at High Lodge in Thetford Forest. Enjoy the peaceful surroundings, woodland walks and play areas then meet up for a burger at lunchtime, what could be better?



Wednesday 12th August - Cromer Beach

Approximate Time - 10am - 4:30 pm - All Ages - £3.50

Cromer is a charming, traditional Victorian seaside town on the North Norfolk coast, renowned for its coastal views and famous Cromer crab. It features a historic pier and lifeboat station.



Wed 12th August - Muckleborough Collection

Approximate Time - 10am - 4:30 pm - Adult £10, Child £8

The Muckleborough Collection is the UK's largest privately owned military museum. It features a collection of tanks, artillery, and armoured vehicles.

We will spend 2 to 3 hours at the museum then be dropped in Cromer for the afternoon.



Friday 14th August - Legoland - Fourways Pick-Up

Approximate Time - 6:30 am - 9 pm - Adult/Child - £45, U3 £15

LEGOLAND Windsor is the UK's premier theme park for families with children, offering over 55 interactive rides, and live shows providing an immersive and creative experience.

It's a long journey of around 4 hours and an early start, but we will be using more comfortable coaches.



PICK UP / DROP OFF - FOURWAYS ONLY

Tuesday 18th August - Great Yarmouth (Bus Only)

Approximate Time - 10am - 5pm - All Ages - £3.50

Probably Norfolk's best known seaside town with plenty to keep the whole family occupied for the whole day. This price is just for the bus, you can add on the Pleasure Beach or Circus if you would like to.



Great Yarmouth Extras

Want more to do? Book one or both of the following activities. **You will also need to book the bus.**

Pleasure Beach (£16) - A mixture of high-octane rides and traditional attractions. Your wristband will give you unlimited access to the rides for the day.



Circus (£16) - This spectacular family show includes circus acts from all around the world. Under 3's can go on your lap. **Doors open at 2pm.**



Wednesday 19th August - Southwold Beach

Approximate Time - 10am - 4pm - All Ages - £3.50

Southwold is a charming seaside town on the Suffolk coast, renowned for its sandy beach, colourful beach huts, and lighthouse. It features a historic pier, independent shops, and the famous Adnams Brewery.



Friday 21st August - Colchester Zoo

Approx Time - 9:30 am - 4:30pm - Adult - £25, Child - £20, U3 - £8

Colchester Zoo is a premier, award-winning zoo home to over 150 species. It's a large site for a full-day experience, Offering close-up animal encounters, interactive zones, and immersive African and Asian habitat zones Travel time will be around 1 and 3/4 hours.



Wednesday 26th August - Gorleston Beach

Approximate Time - 10am - 4pm - All Ages - £3.50

Our normal end of Summer trip to Gorleston. A stunning bay with a huge, wide curving, sandy beach with ramp access. With adjoining shops, cafes, amusements and amenity area, everything you need is close by.



Friday 28th August - Roarr!

Approximate Time - 10am - 4pm - Adult/Child - £18, U3 - £3.50

Rides, indoor and outdoor play areas, a splash park, a petting zoo and giant dinosaurs! Roarr! Is always one of our more popular trips and is fun for everyone.



Coach Rules

Be on Time

Try to be at your stop five minutes early. You might have to wait for us to arrive (mainly due to traffic) but it's better than missing the bus. If you are late we won't wait! Same goes for the return journey, be aware we have left people behind before!

Sit Down and Belt Up!

It's the law! If you (or someone in your care) is caught without your seatbelt on YOU and the driver will both be fined. If you are not sitting down with your seatbelt on, the driver has the right to pull over and ask you to get off.

Same Seats Out and Back.

Please sit in the same seats for the trip there and back. People may have left things on or near their seats and if you don't sit in the same seats it can upset people and cause confusion when we check who's on the bus.

No Swearing.

There are small children on most of the busses, please just don't do it!

No Alcohol.

Pretty self explanatory. We may ask you to get off the bus if you are drinking alcohol, or not let you on if you are drunk!

No food on the coach

Due to the new coach company rules, there will be no eating allowed on the coaches.

Wear Headphones

If you are going to use phones, tablets or whatever to play games, watch movies or anything else then please use headphones. Not everyone on the bus has the same taste!

Code of Conduct

All young people, families, staff and volunteers must act and treat everyone in the way that they would like to be treated themselves. Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated and may lead to an individual or families being refused attendance on further activities. On the family trips, parents/carers remain responsible for children and young people in their care at all times. All activities are alcohol and drug free.

In fairness to other families, at the end of each family trip, everyone must return to their coach on time.
